Surrounding the ball, there is a brand new implementation of the award-winning Scroll Ring that puts scrolling right at your fingertips. More comfortable than ever, the Expert Mouse even comes with a **soft new wrist rest** right in the box! You get all of these great new features along with the same, large ball, exceptional control, and ease-of-use that has set the industry standard for more than 15 years.

I am selling this item in the original manufacturer's packaging, including the trackball, wrist rest, USB cable with USB/PS2 adapter, MouseWorks CD (See notes below), and ReadFirst manual. Although the Kensington Five-Year Warranty applies only to the original purchaser, I purchased this trackball just a little over a year ago (November 2008) and used it very little: Having always worked with a mouse, I wanted to try a trackball. Although my personal preference is still for a mouse, many others prefer a trackball; and the Expert Mouse trackball has indeed earned a great reputation, for its performance, comfort, and overall design.

System Requirements

- PC running Windows 98, Me, 2000, or XP with an available USB or PS2 port (See note below for Windows Vista, Windows 7, or Any 64-Bit PCs).
- Mac running OS X or later with an available USB Port.
- Internet connections or CD ROM drives to install the software.

Note for Windows Vista, Windows 7, or Any 64-Bit PCs: Kensington does *not* warrant that its MouseWorks software, required to program and use the Expert Mouse, will run on any PC with greater than Windows XP or on any 64-bit PC, including those with XP. However, there are workarounds, at least for 32-bit Vista machines, that have been developed among the large, loyal following of the Expert Mouse, as discussed here: <http://sci.rutgers.edu/forum/showthread.php?t=92390> (installing and running the software in winxp Compatible Mode etc.). Although that and other articles are widely cited online, I cannot guarantee any of those workarounds. My personal experience has been that the MouseWorks software did indeed cause fatal errors running on my 64-bit Vista laptop but ran perfectly well on my 32-bit XP desktop.

If you have the proper PC or Mac and like a trackball -- as for its freeing up valuable "real estate" on your desk top -- then **you will find no better trackball than this!**
